

Tour to Liberty, Kentucky

Tuesday, June 5th

Total Miles: 81.1

Start tour by 8:30 am or before

Today's route you will see Danny's Rod Shop and his car collection and then country roads to the Amish/Mennonite area of Liberty, KY. Please take your brochure with you that day as there is a map of all the Amish businesses in the area and most are on just a couple of roads. We will have lunch at the Bread of Life Cafe, which is an Amish/Mennonite Restaurant that support the local children's home. This lunch is not pre-paid, and the buffet prices are very reasonable - your best choice! After lunch we will have scenic roads and creek crossings to Nancy, where you can tour the Mill Springs Battlefields and Museum. Just down the road is Haney's Apple Farm. You can get a fried pie and they have the best Apple Butter! Tonight's supper is hosted by Somernite's Cruise and is near the hotel at one of their member's home. We will be treated by Somernite's Cruise and see the collections of Dr. Carter Blevins, a local oral surgeon. There will be a lot of cars and signs and gas memorabilia for you to enjoy!

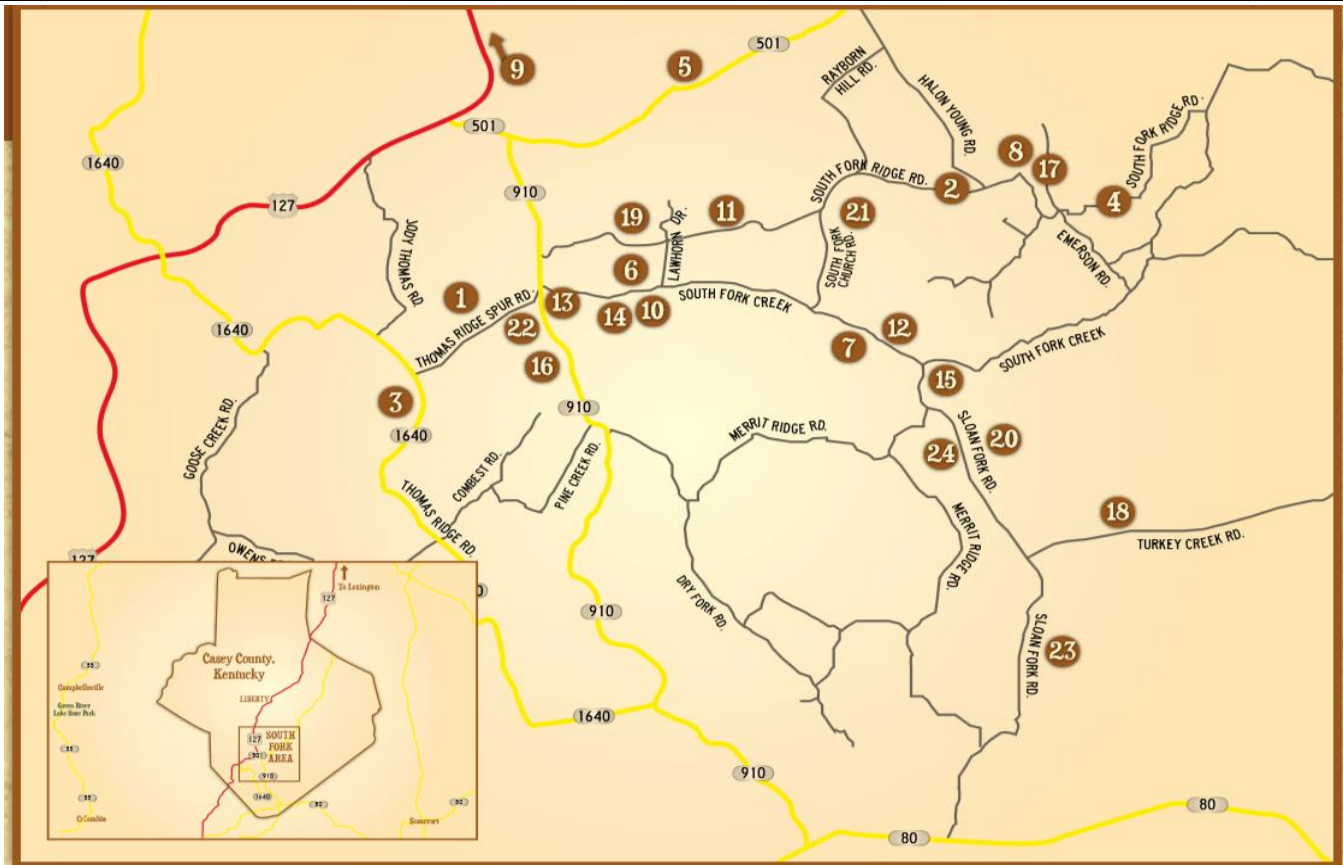
From Holiday Inn Express to Danny's Rod Shop 9.1 Miles

1	Depart Holiday Inn Express toward US-27	0.1 mi
2	Turn left onto US-27 N . You may turn left at a traffic light or make a U-turn at traffic light. However you do it, go North on US-27.	1.0 mi
3	Turn right onto KY-2292 . Mellow Mushroom on Corner. Light 19	2.3 mi
4	Keep straight onto KY-1247 North/Main St after crossing big bridge and continue through the town square and cross KY-80 at traffic light. Not BUS-80	2.0 mi
5	Turn left onto KY-1575/University Dr. at stop sign	0.5 mi
6	At traffic light, turn right onto KY-2227 (Old US-27) Antique Mall will be on the right - they have restrooms if they are open - they open at 9 am.	2.8 mi
7	Turn left onto KY-1247 at stop sign.	394 ft
8	Turn left onto US-27 S at traffic light	0.3 mi
9	Turn right onto Norwood Rd which is the 1st road to the right	436 ft
10	Arrive at Danny's Rod Shop on the right corner	

From Danny's Rod Shop to Liberty KY for Lunch 31.4 Miles

1	Turn right when leaving. Do not go toward US-27. Continue on Norwood Rd at 1st intersection. At 1st stop sign turn left. All on Norwood Rd.	1.6 mi
2	At stop sign turn right onto KY-1674	2.0 mi
3	Turn left onto Hall Ridge Rd before crossing bridge. You will cross a creek and go up a big hill. *****Alternate Route: Do not turn on Hall Ridge Rd, instead, cross bridge and then follow road to the left up the hill. At stop sign turn right and continue on route.*****	2.2 mi
4	Turn right onto Beech Grove Rd at stop sign	3.1 mi

5	Turn left onto KY-1676 at stop sign, at T. No sign, use caution!	9 mi
6	Turn right onto KY-837 at stop sign	0.2 mi
7	At the next intersection, turn left onto Turkey Creek Rd - Steep down hill	4.1 mi
8	At T intersection, turn right onto Sloan Fork Rd . You are in the Amish area, you have a brochure in your goody bag of all the businesses in the area and surrounding roads. Please look at that for more information. You will pass South Fork Kettle Corn and antique shop. This is where your Kettle Corn came from in the goody bag.	1.9 mi
9	Turn left onto South Fork Creek Rd at stop sign	3.2 mi
10	Bear right onto KY-910 at stop sign	1.8 mi
11	Turn right onto US-127 at stop sign	2.3 mi
12	Arrive at Bread of Life Cafe on right for lunch - PAY ON YOUR OWN	
	The last intersection is Allen Creek Rd If you reach Faulkner Dr, you've gone too far	



From Liberty KY to Nancy, KY 30.4 Miles

1	Depart Bread of Life to the left	2.3 mi
2	Turn left onto KY-910	0.5 mi
3	Turn right to stay on KY-910	7.4 mi
4	Turn right onto KY-80/KY-910 at stop sign	0.1 mi

5	Turn left onto KY-910	1.7 mi
6	At green and white house on corner, turn left onto Pinetop Rd , road name changes to Brown Ridge Rd	1.8 mi
7	Turn left onto Finley Owens Rd after crossing bridge (low gear hill)	1.7 mi
8	Turn right onto House Fork Creek Rd at bottom of steep hill. If you get your wheels wet, you are going the right direction! This is a shallow solid bottom crossing. *****In case of high water, do turn left at bottom of steep hill and cross bridge and follow to KY-837 and turn right. Join the route by turning left at New Pleasant Point Church and back on route - this is a long way around!*****	2.7 mi
9	Road name changes to Pleasant Point Rd at church, and no stop signs in 5 point intersection - dangerous intersection. At this intersection you will go straight and onto the road with the "We love our children" sign.	3.6 mi
10	Turn left onto KY-196 at stop sign	0.3 mi
11	At the next road, turn right onto Faubush Norfleet Rd	2.2 mi
12	Turn right onto KY-1664 at stop sign	1.1 mi
13	Turn left onto Roberts Port Rd after red barn on left	4.4 mi
14	Bear left onto KY-235 at stop sign toward Hwy 80	0.3 mi
15	Turn right onto KY-80 at stop sign. Gas station on left	0.3 mi
16	Arrive at Mill Springs Battlefield on the left. The museum is open special for your to tour 1:00-3:00	

To Haney's Apple Farm 0.6 Miles

1	Depart Mill Springs Museum to the left	0.6 mi
2	Arrive at Haney's Appledale Farm on left. Best Fried apple pies and Apple butter in KY! If you reach KY-3189 / Pulaski County Park Rd, you've gone too far	

Back To Hotel 9.6 Miles

1	Depart Haney's to the left . <i>Pulaski County Park is a really neat place to visit if you have extra time.</i>	3.9 mi
2	Turn right onto Patterson Branch Rd - 1st road after Fishing Creek bridge	1.7 mi
3	Turn right onto KY-3261 at stop sign	0.2 mi
4	Turn right onto KY-1577 / Oak Hill Rd no sign, but a traffic light Shell on the corner	2.2 mi
5	Turn left onto KY-1642 / Slate Branch Rd at stop sign	0.5 mi
6	Cross KY-914 E / Southeastern Byp at traffic light	0.4 mi
7	Turn left onto Madira Dr. after "Road May Flood" Sign	0.3 mi
8	At stop sign turn right onto Shearwood Ave and turn left in front of Citizen's Bank to go to Holiday Inn Express before getting to US-27	0.4 mi
